Joanne Rodriguez is our financial consultant and is prepared to assist clients wishing to create a spending plan, lower their debt, raise their credit score, save and invest for retirement, understand the BRS and TSP, and prepare for a large purchase.

Cindy Erdeljac is always willing to help families with special needs dependents navigate the overwhelming resources available to them from Jefferson City to Kansas City.

For anyone wishing to enhance their chances for employment Raxsel Colburn is the person to contact for anyone wishing to enhance their chances for employment as she specializes in resume assistance and job connections.

MSgt Alex Luebrecht and TSgt Adam Magdaleno are our two Readiness NCO's and they are there to take care of pre-and post-deployment briefing requirements while hosting Hearts Apart events for the family members left behind.

Gerald Torres specializes in relocation in the military and is the person who can help relieve some of that stress through Newcomer's Orientation, Sponsor training and Plan My Move for those leaving Whiteman.

Jennifer Sponseller is the wing's 24/7 Casualty Assistance Representative and her responsibilities include casualty reporting to AFPC, notification team coordination and Survivor Benefit Plan point of contact for all retirees.

Jenny Sherman and Jamie Kolakowski tag team to take care of our Airmen or Guardians separating or retiring from active duty, and are the experts running the Congressionally Mandated Transition Assistance Program (TAP, not TAPS). They are here to help prepare service members and their families for a return to civilian life starting one to two years out! With all this

Heidi Parks is our gatekeeper and the first face you'll see walking into the facility. She greets everyone with a smile, schedules all appointments and registers clients for our workshops.

Kathy Kempton (and Charlie), Melanie Roberts-Fuston, and Angela Boone play a vital role as our three contracted Adult Military Family Life Counselors. They can provide active duty and their dependents with brief, solution focused, non-medical counseling.

Jessica Morthole is the local Department of Veterans Affairs Benefits and Services Coordinator, providing information on the plethora of benefits available to our veterans. If none of these amazing people can help you, we can point you in the right direction!

The M&FRC offers the following fantastic workshops: Bundles for Babies I offered quarterly for new or expecting parents to ease the stress of adding a small member to the family, the quarterly Whiteman Life; Welcome Home Spouse Orientation for spouses to learn about the resources available to them, and monthly Military Life Cycle classes on Education and Disability Compensation Benefits. Our annual Operation SPIRIT mock deployment is always the highlight of kids as they wind down the school year heading into summer break.
