



What is Month of the Military Child?

The history of this special celebration goes back to 1986, when Defense Secretary Caspar Weinberger established April to represent military children and their fearlessness. As a father and veteran. he reflected on his time of service and realized how many sacrifices and challenges his children faced as a result. So, he decided to create Month of the Military Child (MOMC) to recognize and celebrate the strength, courage, and resilience it takes to be a military child.

Why Purple?

The color purple is significant because it's a combination of all the colors of the U.S. Armed Force: Air Force, Navy, and Coast Guard all use shades of blue, the Army use green, and the Marines use red.

Why Dandelion?

Military children, akin to dandelions, demonstrate resilience and adaptability as they navigate frequent relocations due to their parents' military service. Their ability to thrive in diverse environments reflects their strength in overcoming adversities. Military kids grow where they land.

Did you know...

- There are **more than 1.6** The average military child million military children who face many challenges and unique experiences as a their families move every result of their parents service.
 - moves 6 to 9 times during their school career, and two to three years.
 - There are more children than service members by a ratio of **1.4 to 1**.
